dwelling which divides the cultivated land
from the uncultivated, and which contains
about forty acres, more or less, and also
all the money which I have invested or
deposited in the Bank of Nova Scotia, or any
other Bank, To Have and to Hold the said
Real Estate and money to him the said
James Harris his heirs and assigns for ever.
Second, I will devise and bequeath to my son
Edward Harris the remainder of my farm and
Real Estate and also all the remainder of
my personal property of every nature and
kind and wheresoever situated, To Have
and To Hold the same to him the said
Edward Harris his heirs and assigns for ever,
Subject however to the payment of all my
just debts and the settlement of my estate
and the Costs and Charges thereof.

Third I nominate constitute and
appoint the said James Harris and
Edward Harris the Executors of this
my last will and Testament.
