do make publish and declare this to be my Last  
Will and testament.

First, I will and bequeath to my beloved sister

the sum of Fifty Dollars and to my beloved niece  
Alice Arnold Harris at present of Oberlyville N.  
S. the sum of twenty dollars said two legacies to be  
paid out of my personal Estate within one year  
after my decease -

Second, I will and bequeath to my beloved wife  
Margaret Jane Harris the sum of Four Hundred  
Dollars out of my personal estate.

Third, I will devise and bequeath to my said  
beloved wife for her use and the use of my child-  
-ren during her natural life should she remain  
unmarried all the residue of my personal estate  
whatsoever and also all my real Estate whereso-  
-ever situate, the same at her decease to go to  
and be equally divided among my children her  
surviving, but in the event of her marrying again  
then I will and direct that my said Real Estate and  
whatever personal property may remain be equally  
divided among my children when they shall have  
attained to the age of twenty one years -

Fourth - I hereby nominate, constitute and appoint  
my said wife Margaret Jane Harris the sole  
Executrix of this my last will and Testament and  
the Guardian of my children during their minority.
