

SAILING VESSELS FROM SCOTLAND TO PICTOU, 1767 - 1850

306 vessels from Scottish ports arrived in Pictou in the 83 year period. Of these, at least 235 are known to have conveyed passengers. It is probable that many of the remainder also carried people to this province. A graph would show a high immigration in the years (1815-22) following the end of the Napoleonic Wars. Another and much more modest peak period occurred just after the turn of the century (1801-04).
