understanding do make this my
last will and Testament in manner

First I give and bequeath to Ruth

of the house in which I live that
is the south east end together with
one half acre of land the east
half together with all my personal
property that I may possess at my
death including money notes cattle
household furniture &c

Secondly I nominate and appoint
Duncan F. Cameron my executor
to this my last will and Testament
I do witness when I do hereby
set my hand seal to this my last
will and Testament in presence of the
witnesses who at my request and in
my presence and in the presence of
each other do set their names
