I, Sarah Hislop of the Town of Picton in the County of Picton and Province of Nova Scotia, Dominion of Canada, being of sound mind and memory, and considering the uncertainty of this frail and transitory life, do therefore make and declare this to be my last Will and Testament, that is to say:

First, After all my lawful debts and funeral expenses are paid and discharged, I bequeath to my sister Mary Jane Hislop my half of the dwelling house and land connected therewith, which we now occupy as a homestead; and all my furniture and household goods, including pictures, books, linen, china, plate, provisions, chattels and effects, which shall at my death be in or about our dwelling house, or the out buildings or grounds thereof.
