publish this my last will and testament

I give and bequeath to my beloved

whereon I now live together with the
Tackling Horses and furniture need all
the harness and Cattle there used belonging
or may yet belong to me to have and
to hold to her and her heirs with the
appertinances during her natural life
After her decease the whole estate
of goods shall become the property
of my son James Daniel Blackie
on the 30th day of October

That he remain at home and
cultivate the farm that it may
yield a comfortable maintenance to
the family

That he give to my daughter
Anne Blackie the privilege
of living at home as she may
desire while she remains unmarried

That she receive a dowry from the
estate of her deceased father of her ownings

If the said James Daniel Blackie
should not remain at home and
cultivate the farm during his natural
life time he will yearly pay his

all mine to the aforesaid property

my last will and Testament
