I Elizabetha Jones of Pictou in
the County of Pictou widow of William
Jones late of Pictou of said Merchant
deceased do hereby make publish
and declare this to be my last will
and Testament hereby revoking all
wills by me at any time heretofore
made

I appoint my son George D Jones
and Frederick W Fraser Druggist of
said Pictou to be the executors and
trustees of this my will

I give devise and bequeath to
Margie Jones wife of my son Charles
W Jones the bill of Sale or Chattel
Mortgage filed in the Registry of Deeds
for Pictou County on or about the
16 day of February ad 1884 and made
by the said Charles W Jones as grantor
to me as grantee, the money due me
thereon, the household furniture and
other property therein described or
conveyed and I also give to said
Margie Jones all other my household
furniture now in her possession or
that of her husband Charles W Jones

I also give and bequeath to said
Margie Jones all my case of Silver
ware (except the tea service herein
after mentioned) now in her possession
I give and bequeath to my daughter

Annua allows my writing desk and
Silver Tea Service

I give and bequeath to Deanna Mrs
wife of my son Arthur Mrs all my
household furniture now in the farm
house on the south side of the West
River Road where they reside

I give and bequeath to Christman
daughter of the said Arthur Mrs one share
in the Merchants Bank of Maryland
Capital Stock now held by me

I give devise and bequeath all my
real and personal estate not hereinbefore
of unto my said executors and Trustees
in trust that they my said executors
and Trustees shall sell call in and
convert into money the same or such
part thereof as shall see fit consist of
any and shall with and out of
the moneys proceeds by such sale
calling in and conversion and with
and out of my ready money pay my
funeral and funeral expenses and debts
and shall have possession of the residue
or remainder upon the trusts following
to pay the following legacies

1 To pay my son William H Mrs
the sum of one thousand five hundred
dollars

2 To pay my son George D Mrs the
sum of six hundred dollars

3 To pay my grandson Fred Mrs
son of George D Mrs the sum of one
hundred dollars

4 To pay to Willie and Christman
Jones the children of my son Charles
W Jones the sum of fifty dollars each
5 To pay to David Fraser, Lewis
and Louisa children of my son Arthur
Jones the sum of fifty dollars each
6 To pay to Daniel F Harris and
Christman Harris children of my
daughter Emma Harris the sum
of fifty dollars each

If any residue and monies be then
remaining I will and direct that the
same shall be equally divided between the
respective wives of my sons George &
Charles W and Arthur Jones and my
daughter Emma Harris to each an
equal share

It is also my will and hereby
expressly declare and direct that the
foregoing devises and bequests are
perpetually intended to be and shall
be construed to be in full satisfaction
and discharge of any debts or debts
which at the time of my death
may be owing by me to such respective
devises or legatees or the husband or
wife of such respective devisee or legatee
whether such legacy or devise shall
be less or more in value or amount
than the debt owing or claimed
I do also will and direct that
should any of the legatees under this

my will or the husband or wife of
such legatee after my death commence
any legal proceedings against my
executors or estate for the recovery
of any alleged indebtedness that
thereupon all my heirs and legatees
shall before, plead to such legatee
with the husband or wife of the person
commencing such proceedings shall
take detrimment and become in part
null and void
