 Sictou as his Agents on the one Part, and William Campbell of  
 Buto as a private Farmer on the other part Witnesses, That for  
 & in consideration the sum of Thirty One pounds, five shillings  
 current Money of Nova Scotia Province to the said Walter Paterson  
 or the said William Gordon as his Agent in hand, the Receipt where  
 of is hereby acknowledged, and each of them the said Walter Paterson  
 and the said William Gordon doth hereby acquit, Exonerate, Release  
 and for ever discharge the said William Campbell, his Heirs, ex  
 -ecutors and Administrators by these presents, and for divers <sup>other</sup> good  
 causes and considerations, He hath granted Bargained Sold  
 Alien'd, Enfeoff'd, released, & Conferred unto the said William Camp  
 bell his Heirs, executors, Administrators, & Assigns - All that tract  
 of Land containing One Hundred & Twenty five Acres more or less  
 and is bounded as follows that is to say, beginning at the east

corners of a Tract of Land belonging to James Grant and  
running North three Hundred & Twenty Perches, and from thence  
east Sixty two & a half Perches, Thence South three Hundred &  
twenty Perches and from thence west the different Courses of the  
Harbour Sixty two & a half Perches untill this Line intersect the  
Line at the east Corner of this Tract of Land belonging to  
James Grant aforesaid. The Whole Whereof to contain One  
Hundred & Twenty five Acres, with an allowance of Five  
per Cent. for High Ways &c. With all manner of Mines opened &  
unopened thereon, saving & Preserving nevertheless unto the  
King his Heirs, and Successors, all white Pine Trees that may  
be found thereon, and also all mines of Gold, Silver, Copper  
Brass Lead & Coals. To Have & to hold all and singular  
the Premises above mentioned unto the said William Campbell  
his Heirs, Administrators, & Assigns forever. And the said  
Walter Paterson doth hereby for himself, his Heirs, Executors  
& Administrators, And he the said William Gordon as his  
Attorney, do hereby covenant & agree with him the said William  
Campbell; That he his Heirs & Assigns may from time to  
Time, & at all times occupy & enjoy the said Premises without  
trouble or molestation according to the true meaning of these  
Presents. Further more the said Walter Paterson and the  
said William Gordon as his Attorney do hereby bind  
themselves, and each of their Heirs, Executors & Administrators  
& Assigns; and against all and every other Person & Persons  
whatsoever to the said William Campbell his Heirs and Assigns  
for ever, In witness whereof the said William Gordon by  
Virtue

By virtue of the aforesaid Powers of Attorney from the  
said Walter Paterson, dated the twelfth day of October, One  
Thousand seven hundred & eighty six, both hereto put the  
Hand & Seal of the said Walter Paterson and the said William  
Gordon also the said William Campbell have hereto
