in the said County, widow, the sum of Two hundred dollars.

I give, devise and bequeath the residue of my prop-
erty, both real and personal, of whatsoever kind and description
and wheresoever situate, unto my infant daughter Jean Johnston.

I direct my executor to sell either at public
auction or private sale all and any real or personal estate
which I may own or be interested in at the time of my decease.

I also direct my said executor to hold in trust the
the entire interest coming to my said daughter Jean and to
pay the same to her or the person in whose custody she may
be from time to time as in his opinion she may require it for
her education and maintenance, and when she attains the age of
eighteen years to pay to her in full the balance if any, which
may be due her.

I nominate and appoint George S. Munro of Westville
in the County of Pictou, Merchant, to be the sole executor
of this my last will.
