my Executors hereinafter named find that it would be

Estate to them herein devised; I herein authorize them
to dispose of the same to the best advantage and to
place the proceeds on interest for their benefit, should
the said Act be not required for their support and
education whatever amount received is to be delivered
to them when they arrive at the age of maturity. or
