£ 33. 13. 0 Confession by plea on Indebitatus Assumpsit
£ 5. 8. 0 between the said Patrick Desmond and Jane Desmond
£ 39. 1. 0 his wife and the said Joseph M. Staught as
well for the sum of Thirty three pounds and thirteen
shillings Damages and Costs of suit. Therefore
it is considered that the said Patrick Desmond
and Jane Desmond his wife do recover against
the said Joseph M. Staught their damages aforesaid
of Thirty three pounds and thirteen shillings
and also the sum of Five pounds and eight
shillings for their costs of suit amounting in all
to Thirty nine pounds and one shilling and
the said Joseph M. Staught in Mercy &c.
