I hereby nominate and appoint
my beloved wife Christy and David Tattin Esq.
and Rev. H. B. Mackay to be the executors of this
my last Will and testament, and I hereby
revoke, ~~cancel~~ and annul all former wills,
legacies, bequests &c. whatsoever, and declare
this as my last Will and testament, on the Tenth
day of April One Thousand eight hundred and
Eighty
