In the name of God, Amen
I, Robert Soudsburg of the West River in the
County of Putnam, Farmer, being at present in a poor
state of bodily health but of sound mind and
memory, thanks be given unto God, Knowing that
it is appointed unto all men once to die, Do
make and ordain this my Last Will & Testament,
Revolving all former Wills

First of all I give and recommend my soul
unto the hands of Almighty God who gave it
and my body I recommend to the earth to be
buried in a decent Christian burial, at the
discretion of my Executors and Executors here-
inafter to be named.

As regards such worldly estate
as it hath pleased God to give me, I give
and dispose of the same in the following
manner viz. First I order that all my just
debts and funeral expenses be fully paid.
Secondly I order that my beloved wife Sennet
Soudsburg shall have a comfortable living
of my Farm and her choice half of the present
dwelling House during her natural life time.
Thirdly I bequeath my Farm on which I
now reside unto my two sons William and
David Soudsburg to be equally divided be-
tween them.

Fourthly I order the following sum of money
to be raised from the stock that may be on
the farm and to be paid as follows to my children
hereinafter named, namely, I order the sum of
Eighty dollars to be paid to my son Jasper Soudsburg
when he will be twenty one year of age
and the sum of Eighty dollars be paid to my


Son Georg Lundsberg within three years after
my death, and to my Daughters Elizabeth
Alexie and Jennet Lundsberg the sum of
Twenty Dollars to each of them when they
will come to the age of Maturity, and the
sum of one Shilling or twenty Cents to be paid
to each of my daughters Cleor & Margaret
Lundsberg, and the sum of One Shilling or
twenty Cents to each of my Sons James and John
Lundsberg. I order that my son Robert
Lundsberg will get a good common english
education such as will enable him to be able
to transact common business.

Lastly I appoint as my true and lawful
Executrix and Executor of this my Last
Will and Testament my said wife Jennet
Lundsberg and James Andersson of the said
West River. Ratifying and Confirming
this and no other.
