in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and ninety eight
between the hours of day and
evening & doth in the afternoon
before us Messrs Robert A. Dickson
and John Fair the undersigned
Notaries Public for the Province
of Quebec practicing at the City of
Montreal

Appeared Samuel May & a good
little party at no 33, Lauro
Quene in the said City of Montreal
widow of the late Joseph Jobory in
his life time of Peter in the Province
of Lower Canada Ship Builder

Who being in good health of body
and of sound mind as appeared to
said Notaries has requested us to
receive her last will and testament
which she has made as follows
First I give and bequeath all my
property movable and immovable
of which my Succession may be
composed at the time of my death
without exception to Reuben James
Barclay & Co. Merchants of St
Pauls Church Montreal. & also
the other Messrs Messrs and
William & Co. Shipbuilders all of
Montreal appointed upon trust for the
uses intents and purposes

January 13.

1st I employ the revenues thereof
and also the Capital in so far as
may be necessary for the main-
tenance of my son Frederick &
Johann during his life time

2nd If on the death of the said
Frederick & Johann any part of my
said revenues were paid in the
hands of my said Executors, they
shall pay the same to my nephew
William O'Hara otherwise called
William O'Hara J. O'bay of Canada
Lake Ontario

3rd In the event of the said William
O'Hara Johann dying before my
said son the residue of my estate
of any shall be divided equally
between my two nieces Anne
Tonville & Anne wife of Simon
W. O'Shea and Miss Phillis Telle
both of Cahoyah in the Province of
Nova Scotia

4th The bequests herein contained
are thus made on condition that
the same shall be exempt from
Seizure for the debts of the said
Legacies being intended for their
Alimentary Support

Since I have had approval my said
Trustees the Reverend James Barry
Boris M^r Arthur and William &
Deets to be the Executors of this my

will and I extend their powers as such
beyond the year and day limited
by law and until the full accomplish-
ment of the purposes hereof. I
constitute them the administrators of
my property with power to admit
the will or any part thereof,
receivable or moneys for such
purposes and on such conditions as
they may think proper and to buy
and transfer investments from
time to time as they may see fit.
I further order that their number
shall never be less than three
and that whenever any vacancy
shall occur in their number the
surviving or continuing executor
and administrators shall successively
and for as long a time as the
executor of my will shall last
appoint by will or deed a substitute
or substitutes to fill such vacancy.
In the event of a disagreement
between the Trustees and executors
the majority shall have the
power to act and their action
shall be binding on the whole.
The Trustees shall have the
right to name an agent or agents
to manage the affairs of the Trust.
They shall not be obliged to
make investments in the securities
to which Trustees are by law

protected but they may insert in
any security they deem right
and shall only be responsible for
wilful default - or intentional wrong
Each Trustee shall only be
responsible for such funds as may
come into his hands even though
he should join in discharge
with the other Trustees

If at any time my said Trustees
consider that my said estate
& family is capable of managing
his business affairs prudently they
may hand over to him all the
property belonging or entitled to
him or such part thereof as may
remain in their hands and upon such
delivery the said Trustees shall be
discharged from all further liability
with the said estate. His powers
shall be exercised entirely at the
discretion of the said Trustees and
shall not give my said son any
right to claim the said property
from them in any circumstances
whatsoever

And lastly all the said
Articles hereunto annexed
the Trustee will has been
made by the said Testator
and has by said Trustee & are in
the presence and hearing of the
other Trustees been read to the

Testimony who declared that this deed
contains her will and that the same
has been prepared in accordance
with her instructions and that she
well understood the same well and
performs in the dispositions
therein contained
