do make and publish this my
last will and Testament

And as to my worldly estate
and all the property real or
personal of which I may be
seized and possessed or to which
I shall be entitled at the time
of my decease, I devise bequeath
and dispose thereof in the manner
following to wit -

First, my will is that all my just
debts and funeral expenses shall
by my executor hereinafter named
be paid out of my estate as soon
after my decease as shall by them
be found convenient.

Second I give and devise and
bequeath to my nephew William
Bowen of said Middle River
Yeoman all my right title and
interest in certain lots of land
situate at said Middle River and
conveyed to me by deed of
said Lockard deceased dated
the twenty eighth day of April

in the year of our Lord one thousand
eight hundred and fifty nine and
dearly registered in the Office of the
Registrar of Deeds at Fife in Book
58 pages 581, 582 and 583 as
by reference thereto will appear
with all and singular the
Incomes Outgoings and appurtenances
thereunto belonging or appertaining
as well as all the personal property
of whatever nature of which I
may die possessed To Have and
To Hold the same to him the
said William Cowan his heirs and
assigns forever.

And lastly I do nominate and
appoint my nephew James Cowan
of said Middle Raim brother of the
said William Cowan to be the
executor of this my last will
and Testament.
