revoking all wills by me at any time heretofore made.

sole executrix and trustee of this my last Will
and testament.

I give and devise to my daughter Mary
E. M. Donald the wife of James Short M^r. Donald
all the four lots of land with appurtenances formerly
owned by them and by them conveyed to me by a
deed bearing date the 18th day of April A.D. 1898
and in said deed fully described, for and during
the term of her natural life and should her said
husband survive her then to him for the term of her
natural life and at the death of both of them
the said the said lands to be divided between
the children of said Mary E. M. Donald then
living share and share alike.

All the residue and remainder
of my property real and personal of every
nature and kind whatsoever and wheresoever
situate I give devise and bequeath to my beloved
wife Margaret Logon absolutely, to have and
to hold the same to her the said Margaret Logon
for her heirs and assigns forever.

And I will and direct that the provisions
hereinbefore made for my said wife shall be
a bar to any claim by her for dower or otherwise
in the lands hereinbefore devised to my said
daughter.
