I hereby give devise and bequeath unto
my wife Isabella Logan her heirs Executors and ad-
ministrators for ~~her~~ ^{their} own use and benefit,
absolutely and for ever, all that certain lot piece
or parcel of land situate lying and being on the
South side of the road leading from River John to
Pictou formerly owned by Robert M. Kellaw and by
heirs conveyed to me by Deed and upon which
I now reside containing fifty acres more or less -
together with all and singular the privileges and
appurtenances thereto belonging, and also all
the stock household furniture and other personal
property whatsoever found after my decease, on the
abovementioned and described premises. I
also Do appoint and ordain Isabella Logan my
wife, sole executrix of this my last Will and testament.

And I Do hereby utterly disallow and revoke and
disannul all and every former Testaments, Wills,
and Executors by me in any wise before named,
willed, and bequeathed, Ratifying and confirming
this and no other to be my last Will and Testament.

our Lord one thousand eight hundred and seventy four,
