old in age but sound in mind do
wrote papers and declare this to
be my last will and testament

I give and bequeath to my son
Dimitri R. St. Louis the lot
of land by my father Salt water
and the Pictou land in length
and one hundred acres land in
second division of said place to
him his heirs and assigns forever
I also give him the sum of
one hundred dollars.

I give and bequeath to George
Fountain the adjoining hundred
acres to him his heirs and
assigns forever. I give and
bequeath to my three sisters each
twenty five dollars. I give and
bequeath to Pombalunth School
the money (being) each the
sum of twenty dollars.

I give and bequeath to Anna
Thompson the Queen's Cove
division each the sum of forty
dollars. I give and bequeath
to E. J. Copland, Sarah Town
and Edward, Jane McQueen
Mrs. Ella Roy each the sum
of ten dollars. I give and
bequeath to my orphan girls

The Sum of one hundred Dollars
I give and bequeath to my
nephew George Fullerton the Sum
of one hundred Dollars
Whatever is due after paying
all dues and demands is to be
divided between Jesse W. Queen
and D. R. Howden he is also to
have his choice of the lots of
land already mentioned, all
Sums bequeathed is to be given
pursuantly or to their written
order with the exception of
the personal money that can
be given to Rev. A. Rogers
I appoint Mr. George Douglas
Clerk, and Mrs. Jane W. Queen
my sole executors and administrators
I now have set my seal
and subscribed my name in
the presence of John Grant and
Jesse W. Queen and in presence
of each other this third day of
August in the year of our Lord
one thousand nine hundred and three
