my last will and testament hereby revoking all
former wills and testamentary dispositions heretofore

I devise and bequeath to my son Scott Mc Cabe
all the property of which I may be possessed at the
time of my decease whether real or personal with
the following provisions

1st That said Scott Mc Cabe shall always provide
my wife Isabella with a comfortable home and
other necessaries while she remains in his home
2^d That said Scott Mc Cabe provide a home and
other necessaries for his brother John and the rest of the
Minor children while they remain at home with him

I further devise that should any dispute arise
between said Scott Mc Cabe and his mother or any of
my family regarding his proper fulfillment of the
provisions of this will then said disputes to be settled
by the decision of the executors of this will they
choosing a third party if they fail to agree themselves

I further devise that William Mc Donald Farmer
of Dunham and Howard S Kennedy Farmer
of Alma be the executors of this will
