This is the Last Will and Testa-
ment of the Wellborn Smith McCall
of Loch Brown in the County of Peter
borough. I direct payment out
of my Estate of all just debts and
charges and Testamentary Exp-
enses.

I give devise and bequeath
to my Brother John James McCall
all my Lands Real Estate personal pro-
perty and all my Estate and Interest
Whatever in full my present Real
and personal Estate and out of my
Estate to the said John James McCall
his heirs and assigns.

I also hereby direct that the said
John James McCall shall permit my
Wife to occupy one half of the house
and shall provide for them a competent
support during the Term of their Natural
lives provided that they remain with pro-
perty and assist as far as health will
enable them to cultivate and improve the
same.

I also direct that the said John
James McCall shall keep for my
Wife her mother for her civil use and
benefit and also allow her the half of
the fruit in the orchard each year
and allow my sister Julia Ann
to have a house with her parents
as long as she may require such
and that he give to my Brother
