This is the last will and
Testament of me Robert McEwoll
Senior of the Green Hill in the
County of Pictou Farmer

I give and devise all my
land and real estate consisting of about
thirty acres of land situate at Green
Hill whereon I reside unto my wife
Catherine for her use during the term
of her natural life, and I also give
and bequeath unto the said Catherine
all my furniture stock implements of
husbandry for her use and disposal
during her natural life

After the death of my said wife
Catherine I give and devise my said
land and all my real estate unto my
son Robert McEwoll his heirs and assigns
subject however to the following conditions
and charges namely that my said
son Robert shall pay to my daughter
Jane Ann McEwoll the sum of three
hundred dollars and shall pay to my
daughter Robert McEwoll Blackie the
sum of one hundred dollars and shall
pay to my son John James McEwoll
the sum of one hundred dollars, and
I give and bequeath to the said Jane
Ann McEwoll Robert McEwoll Blackie
and John James McEwoll respectively
the several sums or legacies herein

payable to them respectively and I direct
that the payment of the said legacies
last mentioned shall be a charge on
my said real estate,

I will and direct that at the death
of my said wife all my furniture shall
be the property of my daughter Jane
Green in full and whatever of my
stock, implements of husbandry and
other my own personal estate shall
be left undispensed of by my wife
shall at her decease be equally
divided between the said Jane Ann
Wolcott Robert and my son and

I name and appoint my son
Robert in full and Charles R. Blackwell
of Green Hill as and to be executors
of this my last will and testament
to which I the said Robert in full
Green have set my hand and seal
this twentieth day of April in the
year of our Lord one thousand eight
hundred and eighty two
