

The last Will and Testament of me Daniel M^c
Donald,

I give bequeath and devise to my son George all my interest in a certain Lot of land situate on or in the neighbourhood of Barney's River, and held co-jointly by me with W^m F. McNeuzie as appears by Deed dated the 24th day of September A.D. 1873. and registered in the Registrar's office Victoria on the 13th Feby 1865 in Liber 11 Folio 631.

All the rest or remainder of any property of which I may die ~~possessed~~ possessed real and personal I give bequeath and devise to my wife Mary and my daughters Cecilia, Sarah, Jessie, and Annie, one half to my wife Mary and the remaining half to my four daughters named above share and share alike and I order that the Homestead at New Glasgow be retained for a period of Ten years after my decease as a home for my wife and such of my daughters as elect to live with her, and that during the space of the Ten years specified above, the Homestead must not be sold or any portion of it, without the Consent of my wife and four daughters or of as many of them as are at the time living. The devise above to my wife is in lieu of and in consideration of the relinquishment by her of all her rights of Power.

I hereby appoint my wife Mary, and daughter Sarah to be Executors of this my will, made and executed at New Glasgow the sixteenth day of October A.D. One thousand Eight Hundred and Eighty -
