one half of all live stock of every
kind which may belong to me at
the time of my decease all weapons
and farming implements of every
description then on the farm
and also at the death of my said
wife Mary Ann Mc Donald
all lands and other property
bequeathed to her by this my will
are to be come the property of my
son John B Mc Donald

4 I give devise and bequeath

To my beloved wife Mary Ann
the Donald fifty acres of land
being all that remains of the
homestead property, One half of all
live stock which may be on the
farm at the time of my death
one half interest in house and all
other buildings situate on my
farm as well as all furniture
of every description which the
house may contain
5 all land, interest in house and
other buildings and all other
property bequeathed to my wife
Mary Ann by the 4th paragraph of
this will are on the death of my
said wife to go to my said son
John Olin Donald
