Know all men by these presents that I Donald
McDonald of County Inver Perth, Pictou County,
and Province of Nova Scotia do hereby make and
Publish this my last Will and testament: and
1st I give and bequeath to my beloved son Alexander the
one half of my Farm lying and being situated at
Sunny Brae, Co. Perth, Pictou, and bounded by
the lands of Donald Anderson from the main
road to the rear.

2^d I give and bequeath to my beloved wife and Maud
my beloved Daughter the Piece of Land starting
from the old Grisk Mill leading up by the main
road till the gate opposite the old House, then
following the road thro' to the Barn one Hundred
feet above the house then taking a straight Course
to the Spring at a certain tree, then taking a
straight Course across to the Brook at the
foot of the Hill thence down the Brook till it
comes to the place of Beginning.

3^d I give and bequeath to my beloved son John
that what remains of the half of the Farm joining
D. R. McDonald,

4. I give and bequeath to my beloved wife the Four Cows.

5. I ordain and order that my sons Alexander and
John C. provide and feed one Cow and three sheep,
a Pece, also one Barrel of Flour a piece, and a barrel
of Potatoes between them, Ten bushels of Potatoes
a piece, also provide fire wood for her, all the
Year round.

6th I appoint and order Duncan W. Donald
Elder, to be my sole executor of this my last Will
and Testament.
