do make publick and declare this my last Will
and Testament.

First I give devise and bequeath unto my wife Essie,
All my real and personal property, to have and
to hold the same to her own use during the
term of her natural life.

Second I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter
Lizzie, two thirds, and to my daughter Essie one
third of the remainder of my real and personal
property after the death of my wife, with the
right to a home with my wife at my house at
Hopewell, so long as they remain unmarried,
and nurse and wash upon my wife.

Third, I give devise and bequeath unto my daughter
Margaret Eighty dollars at the discretion of my
Executors, if they are of opinion, that such pay ment
would not materially injure the rights of the before
mentioned devisees.

I nominate and appoint Alexan-
=der M^r Donald of Springville, Carpenter and
John M^r Kay of Millbrook, Farmer, Executors
of this my last Will and Testament and hereby
authorize and empower them in the event of any
said daughters Lizzie and Essie marrying or
leaving their mother without a suitable nurse and
for that purpose to sell and convey all or any
part of any said estate, that may be necessary,
to furnish my said wife with proper maintenance
nursing and attendance during her life, and at
her death to divide the remainder in the proportions
hereinbefore mentioned.
