McDonald conjointly be sole owners of the same be it lands or money or any other property or value of whatever kind or wherever found become the property of the above named daughters.

Secondly, I order and appoint my son Alex'r. Wm. McDonald to execute this my will and testament the expenses of which be paid out of the sum of my estate and should the said Alex'r. W. McDonald for any cause fail to perform this will I further appoint J. W. Green of Mountville to execute the same.

I witness whereof I set my hand and seal this twelfth day of March A. D., 1908, in presence of A. W. McDonald and J. H. Green, and we in presence of each other and at his the testator's request have hereunto subscribed our names as witness.
