sum of fifty Dollars now in the
Bank of Nova Scotia

4th I give devise and bequeath to
Alexander Bell Melville the sum of
fifty Dollars now in the Bank of
Nova Scotia

5th I give devise and bequeath to
my grandson John Alexander
Melville McDonald all my real
property former which I am now
seized and possessed

6th I give devise and bequeath

To my said grandson all my personal
property now excepted that is to say
less that included
I know the condition of this will is
such that is to say that my grandson
the said John Alexander McNeill
the Donald will remain on the farm
during my wife's widowhood to
remain in her possession the portion
that of the house starting from the
hall to you and keep her in
you will during her widowhood

Stuart McDonald of home as executor
of this my last will and testament
