I hereby give devise and bequeath to

real and personal estate of which I may
be possessed at the time of my decease
on the following conditions there is to say
that the said James Daniel Blotzie
shall pay all my just debts and shall
provide for my wife Margaret Blotzie
Blotzie in her old home in the same
way as I have provided for her in my
lifetime in every respect and there he pay
to her annually ten dollars in Cash for
fructed money or for her own private use
besides, and that he shall enable my son
William Allen Blotzie to get a good
education or such an ordinary trade
as the said William Allen Blotzie may
prefer and to pay the cost of his getting
either as far as Grade B in the Common
Schools, and that he the said James
Daniel Blotzie shall also provide a
place in the old home for all my
unmarried daughters until they marry
or leave home of their own accord
and should the said James Daniel Blotzie
fail to perform these engagements to
the satisfaction of my eye and
executing then the property herein
will to him shall be sold by my
executors and executor to discharge
