In the name of God Amen, I Robert M<sup>r</sup> Donald  
of New Lairg in the County of Pictou, and Province  
of Nova Scotia Yeoman, Being at present weak  
and infirm of Body, But of good sense and  
perfect mind and memory, and considering  
the uncertainty of this life, Do make and ordain  
this to be my last Will and Testament in manner  
and form following that is to say, First and prin-  
-cipally I earnestly recommend my Soul to God  
who gave it and my body I Commit to the earth  
to be buried in such decent manner as my executors  
hereinafter mentioned shall think fit, and as  
touching such worldly estate and effects as God  
has been pleased to bless me with, I give, Devise,  
and bequeath the same in manner following to wit:

I give devise and bequeath to my beloved wife  
Ellen M<sup>r</sup> Donald all my worldly Estate and effects,  
with the following exception only, that is to say I devise  
and bequeath the sum of Sixty Dollars to be put  
on interest for the benefit of the Congregation of St<sup>r</sup>  
Andrews Church at New Blairloch the interest to be  
paid yearly to the Trustees of the said Congregation.

And I do nominate and appoint my esteemed  
Friends John M<sup>r</sup> Donald of West river in the County of  
Pictou Yeoman, and David M<sup>r</sup> Donald of New Lairg  
in the County aforesaid, joint Executors of this my last  
Will and testament, thereby revoking and making  
null and void all Wills and testaments by me made  
heretofore and do declare this to be my last Will and  
Testament by which I further devise and bequeath  
that the above named executors of this my last Will  
and Testament shall be paid out of my said pro-  
-perty such fee and reward as shall be lawful for  
their trouble and intromissions.
