I give devise and bequeath to

the household furniture and other
effects of which I may be possessed
at the time of my decease,

To my said wife also I give
devise and bequeath for the term
of her natural life the house in
which I now live in said town
of Glasgow with the lands attached

It is my will that said house
should be a home for any of my
daughters who may remain
unmarried and at the decease of my
said wife I give devise and
bequeath said house and premises
to such of my daughters as are
then unmarried for and during
such time as any of them
remain unmarried, after the

decease of my said wife and
after the marriage or after death
before marriage of all my daughters
I give devise and bequeath
said house and premises to my
two sons share and share alike.

To my son Henry I give devise
and bequeath that lot of land with
the buildings thereon situated near
the forebay of the Methuen Ferry
(land) in said ward of Glasgow
all the residue of my estate I
give devise and bequeath to my
wife.

I hereby recommend and approve
my wife as the executor of this my
will.
