This is the last Will and Testaments of one  
John M<sup>o</sup>. Gregor of Bonds Chance Harbor in the County  
of Pictou and Province of Nova Scotia, Farmer.

I order and it is my Will that all my  
lawful debts be paid by my executors and Executor  
hereafter named.

I give devise and bequeaths to my  
wife Margaret M<sup>o</sup>. Gregor my two farms during the  
time of her natural life with full power and  
Authority to sell and dispose of the same if necessary  
for the maintenance of herself and family. That  
is to say the farm on which I now reside situated  
and being between the lands of the late John  
Cameron on the east and the lands of Daniel  
Cameron on the west. Containing one hundred  
and fifty acres more or less. And the farm  
situate and being between the lands of John  
W. Fraser and James C. Fraser on the east and  
the lands of the late John Cameron aforesaid, on  
the west. Containing one hundred and twenty  
five acres more or less. The said two farms herein  
before described to go to my son John Henry M<sup>o</sup>. Gregor  
at my wife's death, subject nevertheless to the power  
given to my wife the said Margaret M<sup>o</sup>. Gregor  
to dispose of the same as herein before specified.

I give devise and bequeaths to my  
son the said John Henry M<sup>o</sup>. Gregor all my farming  
utensils, household furniture, and personal property  
of whatever kind except money which may be left  
at my wife's decease.

I give devise and bequeaths to my  
Daughters Maria M<sup>o</sup>. Gregor and Bertha Sophia M<sup>o</sup>. Gregor  
all money which may be left at my wife's death -  
to be equally divided between them share and share  
alike.

I also order and it is my will that my said daughters hereinbefore named shall be allowed to remain on the farm with my son John Henry W. Gregor aforesaid and make their home if they choose, while they remain unmarried.

I also order and it is my will that my executrix and executor hereinafter named shall have full power authority to collect all debts due me at the time of my decease and any money or monies belonging to me bearing interest and also to foreclose a mortgage which I hold if the same be not paid.

Lastly I do hereby nominate and appoint my wife the said Margaret W. Gregor Executrix and John P. Reid (Bliss' son) Executor of this my last Will and Testament, and the Guardians of such of my Children as may be under the age of twenty one years.
