I Alexander McHardy of the
City of Glasgow in the County of Pictou and
Province of Nova Scotia in the Dominion
of Great Britain taking into consideration
the uncertainty of life and the certainty
of death do hereby make public and
declare this my last will and Testament
hereby revoking any and all wills hereto-
fore by me made and publishing
and proclaiming this and this only as
my last will and Testament

First I commit my soul to God
trusting for the forgiveness my
sins to the merits and mediation of
my Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ
and as for my worldly property which
it has pleased God to bless me both
real and personal I give devise and
bequeath as follows

Secondly I give and devise to my
beloved daughter Letitia wife of
a R R Hunter of Churchville in the
County of Pictou and Province of
Nova Scotia my dwelling house
and Shop situate on Marsh Street
in the Town of West Glasgow in
County of Pictou and Province of
Nova Scotia abutting bounded as
follows, Beginning at a Point on

Marsh Street two feet from the north west
Corner of said Shop and dwelling
~~house~~ there at a distance of two feet
from said Shop and dwelling house
in a South westerly Course until it
comes to the lands of one James W
Mc Donald once a Living Keeper
thence including the big old barn to
the lands of one Angus Mc Gillivray
thence in a South easterly Course
or direction along said lands of
Alexander Mc Gillivray a distance of
forty feet or such a distance as will
give or all or express and implies to
the said barn, thence in a north-
easterly direction to Marsh Street
opposite, thence in a North westerly
along said Marsh Street to the point
of beginning

Thirdly I give and devise to my son
a Ben Hardy of Mc Gillivray Mountain
in the County of Pictou and Province
of Nova Scotia Farmer the triangular
lot of said site all in the form of
New Glasgow County of Pictou
Dominion of Canada being on the
North west Side of the lot devised
to John Robertson and bounded
on the South east Side by the lands
of James W Mc Donald former

Livery Keeper, on the southeast side
by the lands devised to Letitia Robinson
on the north side by the north street and
on the south by the lands of James
Wm Donald formerly Livery Keeper
Fourthly I give and bequeath to my
daughter Margaret Hamilton ~~Fraser~~
wife of Angus Fraser Carpenter of
Waverly Mass the sum of Two
hundred dollars Cash to be used by
her as she may see fit for the
benefit of her children

Fifthly, I give and bequeath to my
daughter Mary Catherine wife of
William Perry the sum of Two
hundred dollars Cash to be used
by her as she thinks right for the
benefit of her family

Sixthly - I give and bequeath to each
of my grand children the children
of A. C. Hardy on Mt. Killmans
Mountain the sum of Ten Dollars
($\$10^{00}$) to each to be paid by my executors
within one year from my decease

I also give and devise to my four
Grandchildren Children of A. R.
Robinson and Letitia his wife the
sum of Ten dollars to each to be paid
within one year after my decease

Seventhly. I give and bequeath to my

now residing in Blue Hill Maine
one Riding wagon one ^{wagon} Express, also
two pairs of Cart-wheels with iron
axles also one loom for weaving
cloth - 1 Cotton reed one Sewing
Machine, also a number of tools

together all the rest and residue
& remainments of my estate, real and
personal whatsoever situated of which
I may have died seized and
possessed of or in any way entitled
to hold hereupon especially
despised of I give devise and
bequeath to my said son A. Hardy
his heirs administrators executors
and assigns for use and constituting
their regular Regulee to this
my last will and Testament,

my son A. Hardy of M^e Lillons
Mountain in the Province of New
Bedford County of Pictou former
Deputy and my daughter Helen
Brenton of Pictou the Executors
of this my last will and
Testament
