Know all men by these presents that I  
Alexander M<sup>r</sup>. Sutorch of Blue Mountain in  
the County of Pictou and Province of Nova Scotia,  
Merchant, being in ill health but of sound and  
disposing mind and memory do make & publish  
this my last Will and testament; hereby revoking  
all former wills by me at any time heretofore  
made;

And as to my worldly estate and all the  
property real, personal, or mixed of which I shall  
die seized or possessed or to which I shall be  
entitled, at the time of my decease - I devise  
bequeath and dispose of in the manner following.

To wit.

First, My will is that all my just debts and funeral  
expenses shall by my executors hereinafter named,  
be paid out of my estate as soon after my decease  
as shall by them be found convenient.

Item. I give devise and bequeath to my beloved wife  
Elizabeth M<sup>r</sup>. Sutorch all the property real personal  
or mixed of which I shall be entitled at the time  
of my decease together with all the profits, income,  
and advantage that may result therefrom to have  
and to hold the same to my beloved wife the said  
Elizabeth M<sup>r</sup>. Sutorch her heirs and assigns forever.

I do hereby nominate and appoint  
my beloved wife Elizabeth M<sup>r</sup>. Sutorch as guardian  
of our three children viz Catherine M<sup>r</sup>. Sutorch -  
Robert M<sup>r</sup>. Sutorch, and Flora Bell M<sup>r</sup>. Sutorch.

And lastly, I do hereby nominate and appoint  
my said wife Elizabeth M<sup>r</sup>. Sutorch and my brother  
John Robert M<sup>r</sup>. Sutorch of Lunny Bore in said  
County of Pictou to be the executors of this my last  
Will and testament -
