I Donald the Intosh of the parish  
in the County of Pictou and  
Province of Nova Scotia formerly  
being this day of sound and  
disposing mind and memory and  
understanding do make this my  
last will and Testament as follows  
First It is my will that all my  
just debts be paid after my decease  
and that I will be decently buried  
at the discretion of my Executors  
Hereafter named  
Second I give and bequeath to my son  
Dougal the Intosh my real  
estate consisting of one hundred  
and twenty five acres of land which  
is bounded on the north by lands  
of James A. Maclean and heirs of  
Donald Stewart, on the east by  
lands of Robert the Kinnon and  
William the Kinnon, on the south  
by lands of Alexander the Intosh and  
on the west by lands of John Cameron  
I also give and bequeath to my  
said son Dougal the Intosh my  
entire personal property consisting  
of horses, Cattle & sheep, farming  
implements and whatsover I  
may be possessed of at the time of  
my death  
I thus notwithstanding the  
fragility it is my will and it

is the true intent and meaning of  
this testament that my son the said  
Douglas the I Intosh, shall provide  
for my wife Sarah the I Intosh with  
the following during her natural  
life time, that she the said  
Sarah the I Intosh shall have the  
privilege of occupying the dining  
room and bed room in the north  
east corner of my present dwelling  
house, and also that she supply her  
the said Sarah the I Intosh annually  
with the following goods, one barrel  
of flour, one barrel of oatmeal, ten  
bushels of potatoes, five pounds of tea  
ten pounds of sugar, sufficient clothing  
provisions for one stove and also to  
keep continuously for her sole use  
the Dutch Cook and three stoves  
Kately I Intosh and Constable  
for the said Douglas the I Intosh  
the expenses

hand and seal subscribed and set  
this tenth day of April one thousand  
nine hundred and six
