

I Amsted in Hay of Trenton in
the County of Princeton said being of sound
and disposing mind and memory do
make and publish this my last will
and Testament hereby revoking all
former wills by me at any time hereto-
fore made

1st I hereby appoint my son Robert
of Trenton and Red Horse the head of
Newly Lays in the County of Putnam to
be my executors of this my last will
directing my said executors to pay
all my debts funeral and testamentary
expenses out of my estate as soon as
conveniently may be after my decease

2nd After the payment of my said
debts funeral and testamentary expenses
I give devise and bequeath all my
real and personal estate which I may
now or hereafter be possessed of or
interested in in the manner following
that is to say

3 I give devise and bequeath to
my son Robert that certain lot
piece or parcel of land situated in
Trenton being 6th section and
containing in all thirty five
or thereabouts more or less with the
buildings and appurtenances thereto
belonging

4 I also devise and bequeath to
my said son Robert that lot of
land adjoining containing one
quarter of an acre ^{more or less} described in
indenture of purchase dated twenty
sixth day of April one thousand
eight hundred and eighty five
from William R. Faxon

4 I also devise and bequeath

to my said son Rodrick
all my household furniture
and utensils and Chattels of
my decession being in and
on the premises and on the
land known as lots 19 and 20

5- The foregoing disposal of
my property to my said son
Rodrick is made on condition
that he pay to my daughter
Jonhel one hundred dollars
as soon as convenient and also
provide a home for my
said daughter while she
remains single and chooses
to stay with him

6 I give devise and bequeath
to my son Angus that undivided
farm as the above and that
certain lot on which it stands
containing four thousand two
hundred and forty three
or near feet more or less purchased
by me from William R. Faxon
and devised in intention and
right of J. J. Faxon one thousand
eight hundred and eighty six
on condition that he pay
my daughter Mary one hundred
dollars as soon as convenient and
also in this case he should
with to dispose of or sell said
property my son Rodrick should
have the first offer to buy it.
if he chooses to dwell in this house
he shall have the right to sell

Written in the pump on the property
bequeathed to my son Rodrick
provided he help equally to keep
pump in repair.

daughter Isabel my sewing machine
