fifty dollars to the French Foreign Mission
Fund of the Presbyterian Church in
Canada Eastern Section and I
further will and direct that the
receipt of the Treasurer for the
same being of said respective funds

shall be a good and sufficient discharge
to my executors and to my estate.

I give and devise to my niece Susan
McCallum wife of David McCallum
of Victoria Island all my real estate
Messuages and premises on the north
side of Water Street in the Town of
Pictou.
