I give devise and bequeath my Estate and property, Real and Personal as follows.

May in the County of Pictou Fifty Acres of Land, on the South side of the Farm which I now devise and bequeath, and that the said Daniel M. May has to give Wood off the said Fifty Acres, to John Campbell and his heirs while there is Wood on said Lot.

I give devise and bequeath to John Campbell my brother in law, the remaining part of the farm of which I now own containing fifty Acres more or less.

I give devise and bequeath to John Campbell my brother in law all the personal property viz. stock, Farming implements, and Household Furniture, which is now on the said Farm.

I appoint John Campbell Lutherland's River Farmer, and James W. Ross of Lutherland's River Farmer, in the County of Pictou, Executors of this my Will.
