farmer, hereby do make my last Will & Testament,
in the manner following,

Firstly, I will and devise to my wife Jane my farm
on which I now reside,

My Mother is to have a home and living
in all respects as she has been accustomed to, during
her natural life, also my niece Maggie who resides
with my family is to have a home with my family,
and my daughter Letitia May is also to have a home
with my family, while they or either of them remain
unmarried,

Secondly, I will and bequeath to my said daughter
Letitia May the sum of Six thousand five hundred
dollars (\$6,500.⁰⁰)

Thirdly, I will and bequeath to my said niece, Maggie
McKay Postous, six hundred dollars (\$600.⁰⁰)

Fourthly, All the residue of my estate of all kinds
whatsoever, I will and bequeath to my wife Jane,
I desire that she provide for my daughter Hazel, and
my infant child out of this residue of my estate, as she
may deem best.

Lastly, I nominate and appoint George Frederick Chisholm
of Pictou, Banker, and my wife Jane to be the executors
of this my last Will and Testament.

In token whereof I have hereunto my signature and seal
affixed and set, this twenty third day of July A.D. 1899.
