Blacksmith,

1st I give devise and bequeath to my son
James R. M. May the House and Lot on
which I now reside between the lands of
my son in law Angus Chisholm and the Lot
belonging to me on the north formerly occupied
by Thomas Graham, as well as all my personal
property.

2nd I give devise and bequeath to my son George
Forest M. May the said Lot and buildings
to the north of the Lot above bequeathed to my
son James formerly occupied by the said
Thomas Graham, also the Lot on the west
side of Provost street immediately South
of the Lot deeded by me to my said son
James R. M. May, also the lot and building
situated in West New Glasgow formerly occu-
-pied by Ann Dollard.

I nominate and appoint
George Forest M. May and James Rodrick
M. May my sons sole executors of this my last
Will and testament, hereby revoking all
former wills made by me.
