

I James Mackay of Mill Brook in the County of Pickens Farmer, declare this to be my last Will and Testament,

I give devise and bequeath unto my wife Mary McKay the one half of all my real and personal property of every kind and nature except the farm formerly owned by James Traylor to hold use and enjoy as long as she remains my widow, without the power to sell or dispose of any part thereof except by and with the consent of my daughter Georgina L. McKay and after the death of my said wife the whole of my property then remaining to go to and become the property of the said Georgina L. McKay

I give devise and bequeath unto my said daughter in law Georgina L. McKay the other half of all my real and personal property except the aforesaid farm formerly owned James Traylor, absolutely free from the control of her husband or his creditors.

I give and bequeath to my daughter Jessie Seabed wife of David Mackay the farm formerly by James Traylor and situated at Mill Brook in the County of Pickens and containing eighty acres more or less together with the buildings and appurtenances to the said lot of land belonging to hold unto her her heirs, executors, and administrators according to the respective natures and qualities of the said premises absolutely and forever.

I hereby revoke all former wills and codicils made by me at any time heretofore.

I nominate and appoint my said wife Mary McKay and the said Georgina L. McKay sole executors of this my last will and testament.
