the sum of Eighty dollars, also one Cow and
Two Sheep.

Thirdly I will and bequeath to my daughter Anna
Heller the sum of Eighty dollars.

Fourthly I will and bequeath to my daughter Jessie the
sum of Forty dollars.

Fifthly I will and bequeath to my son James the Farm
Lot on which I now reside, together with all the
buildings thereon, I also will and bequeath to
my son James all the stock including horses,
Cattle and Sheep that is on the place, with the
exception of what I have already willed and
bequeathed to my daughters Catherine and
Mary also all the Farming Implements that
is on the place.

Lastly I do hereby appoint George Murray
Medical Doctor of New Glasgow as the Sole
Executor of this my last Will and Testament.
