4. And the residue of such proceeds my said executors shall invest on good and safe security, and disburse the same for the care and support of my son John D. Rae, second, I will and bequeath to my said wife all my household furniture and furnishings.

Third, I hereby nominate, constitute, and appoint my brother James Rae of Delaware
