interests of my son that this
money should be earlier paid to him
or expended on his behalf, it is my
will that they should give it to
him or spend it for him as they
may deem best.

The balance of the proceeds
arising from the sale of my said
property on which shall together
with all my personal property of
whatever nature and kind
including any money I may
have deposited in any Bank and
all debts due me I give devise
and bequeath to my beloved wife
Irene Jane
