4th I also direct that my three
children if living shall each
receive one dollar (\$1.00) of the
lawful money of the Dominion
of Canada then lawfully
as follows Mrs. Florence M.
Ross (McKenzie) N.S., James K.

United States, John William.
Mr Kenzie at present working
in this town

5 I have appointed my wife
Mary a Mr Kenzie executor
and George a Douglas Mechanic
of this town as my executors
of this my last will and testament
