

This is the last Will and Testament of me, Alexander  
McKenzie of New Glasgow in the County of Pictou, Province  
of New Scotia, Tailor.

First, I grant give, devise and bequeath to Margaret  
McKenzie my wife all my real estate and personal  
property for her use during the term of her natural life,  
and I hereby authorize and empower my executors  
to sell and dispose of the whole or any part of any  
real estate or personal property in any manner they  
may consider advisable, the proceeds of such sale to  
be placed at the disposal of my said wife for her  
support and maintenance during her lifetime, as  
aforesaid.

Second, I grant give, devise and bequeath to my  
adopted Children now living with me, to wit, to  
Williamina McLean and Anna McKenzie, in equal  
shares all my real and personal property and the  
proceeds thereof remaining and existing at the death  
of my said wife, the whole of the said "remaining and  
existing property" to become the property of the survivor  
of them the said Williamina McLean and Anna  
McKenzie should either of them die without any  
Children before the demise of my said wife.

Third, I hereby name, authorize and appoint my  
wife Margaret McKenzie and William Fraser, Post-  
master and George Douglas, Merchant, all of New Glasgow,  
aforesaid to be the executors of this my last Will and  
Testament.
