Therefor and to pay annually to my

the income arising from the same

for the maintenance and support of

marry and if the said income shall  
be insufficient for such purpose  
then I direct that she shall  
receive out of the principal such  
additional sum of money as  
may be reasonably

investments to be divided equally  
between them share and share alike  
which I hereby will and bequeath
