to make their home with their mother as long as she lives.

Thirdly, I give and devise to Nancy my daughter
the sum of five pounds of my personal property.

Fourthly, I give and devise to Margaret my Daughter
the sum of five pounds currency of my personal
property.

Fifthly, I give and devise to Margaret Catherine
Robertson my Grandchild the sum of five
pounds currency of my personal property.

Sixthly, I give and devise to Margaret my
beloved wife the remainder of my personal
property.

Verily, I name and constitute Alexander
Vogchart, and Duncan McDonald my Executors.
