Ref.} bequeath unto Alexander my son, and unto his heirs all and singular the Real and personal property owned by me in the said Gairloch Settlement, and elsewhere situated, and owned by me.

Together with all and singular the remaining part of my personal and moveable property of whatever kind and value including all Stock and Farming implements and Debts.

Due unto me, Provided that my above named Daughters Have their living of said property untill the Residue therefrom with privilege of occupying Two Rooms of my house on the second flat and and western part of said House, I appoint and ordain Murdoch McKenzie son of said Gairloch and Robert Raillie of said Settlement to be my executors of this my last Will and Testament, and I hereby utterly Revoke and disannul all former former wills & Testaments by me made and appointed.
