First, I will and direct that all my

charges touching the proving or otherwise
concerning this my will be paid by my
Executors out of my estate.

Secondly, I will and direct the sum of
Two Hundred Dollars to be paid to my
Daughter Georgina when she is Twenty
one years old.

Thirdly, I will and direct that the sum
of Two Hundred Dollars to be paid to
my son David Alexander when he is
Twenty one years old.

Fourthly, I will and direct that the
sum of One Hundred Dollars be paid
to Nathaniel Waguhart at the discre-
tion of my hereinafter named Executors.

Lastly, I will devise and bequeath all
the rest and residue of my personal
property Goods, chattels, and Household
Furniture money notes of hand &c as
also ^{all} my messuages lands tenements and
hereditaments whatever may be left after
my just debts funeral expenses &c
are paid as before mentioned to my wife
Sarah W Urquhart to have and to
hold the same to her and heirs forever
Lastly, I hereby nominate and appoint
Alexander Fraser, Rocklin, Middle River
Anthony Fraser of Westville and my wife
Sarah W Urquhart Executors and Executors
of this my last will and Testament
