knowing the uncertainty of Time do  
hereby and Ordain this my last will  
and Testament

I give devise and bequeath unto  
Charles Floyd of said county son of  
Thomas Floyd and his heirs and  
assigns all the real estate I own in  
the County of Pickens or elsewhere  
including all the title interest and  
claim I have acquired by will of  
my late husband Charles Workman  
or otherwise of the bounded property  
on which I now reside and the  
houses and buildings thereon in  
said tract bounded on the north  
east by the Drummond Road (so called)  
on the South east by the lands of  
One Mr Russell, on the south west  
by lands of Alexander Purvis  
and on the north west by lands  
in possession of one Andrew McNeil  
provided nevertheless that in the  
event of the death of the said Charles  
Floyd previous to his attaining the  
age of twenty one years and his  
widow a child surviving him all  
the above mentioned real estate  
shall revert to and be inherited in  
Bessie Floyd wife of the said Thomas  
Floyd.

I give and bequeath to James Workman

of said Wetherill the sum of four hundred  
dollars

I give and bequeath to Elizabeth  
Worham wife of Thomas Worham  
of said Wetherill the sum of two  
hundred dollars

I give and bequeath to Bessie  
Floyd wife of Thomas Floyd the  
sum of two hundred dollars

I give and bequeath to Alexander  
Wm Bain of said Wetherill the sum  
of twenty five dollars exclusive of  
his fees as executor

I do and desire that the house  
hold furniture fixtures and furnishings  
goods chattels and effects in and  
about the premises in which I  
now reside shall be divided as  
equitably as may be between the  
said James Worham Elizabeth  
Worham and Bessie Floyd

I do and constitute Alexander  
Wm Bain of said Wetherill John  
Clark and James Worham of said  
Wetherill my executors of this my  
last will
